
## SEO Scholars Seizing Every Opportunity

SEO Scholars is a unique, eight-year, academic program, focused on getting underserved, public high school students to and through college — with a 90% graduation rate.



#### Saturday Academy, Weekday Programming, and Summer Academy

SEO Scholars complete 720+ hours of additional academic instruction in Math and English; the equivalent of 2.5 years of ELA instruction and 1.5 years of Math instruction. This is made possible with the help of more than 80 instructors. Throughout 11th grade, Scholars work one-on-one with a mentor who provides career and college guidance.

#### Summer Enrichment Programs (EPs)

Scholars attend EPs, which give them the opportunity to complete an internship, travel abroad, or complete college courses. The Class of 2019 participated in 40 different EPs. Scholars work with our college admissions team to create college lists, write personal statements, and receive guidance on scholarships and financial aid.

## SAT Prep

11th grade Scholars build on foundational skills gained through SEO's core curriculum, with a four-month-long Academic Approach SAT strategy course.

100% of SEO Scholars are accepted to four-year schools.
